Considerations for Assisting Air Travel Passengers with Disabilities During the Coronavirus Pandemic

In response to the coronavirus pandemic, several organizations have developed the considerations that air carriers should observe or implement to ensure that service to passengers with disabilities is provided in a safe and dignified manner in accordance with the Air Carrier Access Act (ACAA). 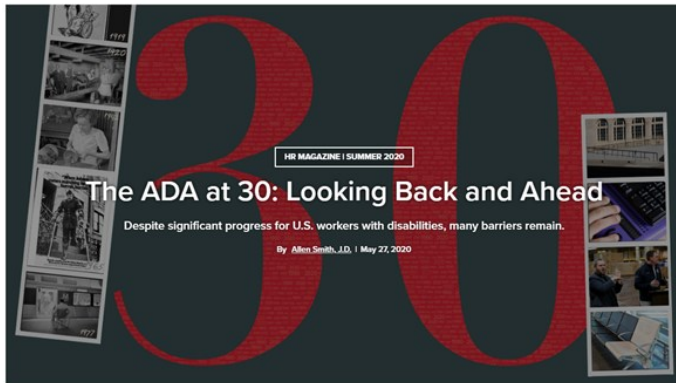
